Assessing Listening Skills with TV and Film

Sample based on the European Language Portfolio
Activity: Watching TV and films
C1/C2 Can follow films employing a considerable degree of slang and idiomatic use
B2 Can understand most TV news and current affairs programs
B1 Can understand a large part of many TV programs on topics of personal interest
B1 Can follow many films in which visuals and action carry much of the story line & language is straightforward
A2 Can identify main points and follow changes of topic of factual TV news items & form an idea of the main content

This is a general scale where examples are given for only one language function—your interpretive listening skills while watching TV or films.

Answer the following questions based on the topic above. If you are working with a partner or in a group, discuss how it is possible to situate yourself on this scale.

1. Where would you rate yourself on this scale? Why?
2. What goals would you set to reach the next level?
3. What learning experiences or practice would you need to meet those goals?
